

Dear Parent,

As you know, our school has adopted *Everyday Mathematics*® as our core math curriculum. As part of this program, we have access to the Everyday Math Online website, which will be integral to your child's learning experience.

The site can be used on almost any computer with high-speed Internet and a common web browser, such as Internet Explorer, Safari, or Firefox. Before you begin, you should

- receive your child's individual Login Card from your child's teacher.
- install (or update) the Adobe Flash and Adobe Shockwave plug-ins from www.adobe.com.
- add exceptions for everydaymathonline.com and emgames.com, if you restrict Internet access on the computer used by your child.

Logging into Everyday Math Online

1. In a web browser, visit the home page at www.everydaymathonline.com. (You may want to “bookmark” the address or save it as a “favorite” to get to it quickly in the future.)

2. In the **Username** box, type the LOGIN name from the Login Card that your child brought home from school. Click the **LOG IN** button.

3. In the **Student Password** box, type or click the PASSWORD from the Login Card, and click the **LOG IN** button. The teacher chooses the password format, but you should see a form on screen that matches the format on the Login Card.
